Web survey using computer-assisted Web interviewing (CAWI) technology.



1,507 Canadians were interviewed through a Leger Omnibus survey.



Between June 17 and 19, 2022.

METHODOLOGY

Leger Canada Omnibus



Using data from the 2016 Census, results were weighted according to gender, age, native language, region, education level and presence of children in the household in order to ensure a representative sample of the population.

8 in 10 say the Canadian flag represents their pride in Canada.



Those 45+, from Ontario and Western Canada are most likely to say it represents their pride, while younger Canadians and those from Quebec are more likely to say that it doesn't.

Does the Canadian flag represent your pride in being Canadian? 79% YES (NET) 43% Yes – very much Yes – somewhat 36% NO (NET) 18% No – not very much 12% No - not at all I don't know / I prefer not to



answer

8 in 10 claim the Trucker Convoy will not impact how they celebrate Canada Day this year.



Those over 45 are more likely to say the Trucker Convoy will have no impact on how they celebrate, and over half of Quebecers say they did not intend to celebrate anyway. Younger (18–24-year-olds) and those in the West are more likely to say the trucker convoy will have a negative impact on how they celebrate.

Three quarters of Canadians say Residential Schools will not impact how they celebrate Canada Day this year.



West

Like with the Trucker Convoy, older (35+) Canadians are more likely to say that Residential Schools will have no impact on how they celebrate Canada Day, with more than half of Quebecers saying they did not intend to celebrate anyway. Younger Canadians (under 35) and those from Ontario are more likely to say it will have a negative impact on how they celebrate.

Have Residential Schools had an impact on how you 55-64 will celebrate Canada Day this year? 77% NO IMPACT (NET) 42% No impact – will celebrate anyway No impact – did not intend to 35% celebrate **NEGATIVE IMPACT (NET)** 23% Negative impact – I will celebrate 11% somewhat less because of this Negative impact – I will celebrate a 6% lot less because of this Negative impact – I will not 5% celebrate at all because of this


Q2. Residential Schools- Have the following recent events or news stories had a negative impact on how you will celebrate Canada Day this year? Base: Canadians (n=1507)







